IN MEMORY OF RICHARD D. MAHONEY



Richard "Dick" D. Mahoney served as Telephone Credit Union of NH (currently Bellwether Community Credit Union) senior executive for 36 years. During that time, he grew the credit union from \$1 million to more than \$190 million in assets. He was affectionately known as "Mr. Credit Union" to the credit union community for the dedication and commitment to the credit union philosophy of "people helping people." He has a deep-rooted devotion to his credit union and ingrained principals of integrity, service and member value throughout the organization.

While Dick is known for his dedication to the credit union, his passion was his family. His life centered around his wife Beverly, their three daughters and grandchildren. He was also committed to the community, serving on several non-profits boards including chairing the New Hampshire Credit Union League Social Responsibility Committee. Under his leadership, the partnership between the state's credit union and Make a Wish Foundation of NH was founded.
