Not long after, they provided Dandre with a brand-new bed and everything he needed to sleep comfortably. Seeing him have a space of his own, something just for him, was a big relief. I'm grateful for the support that made this possible.

Walín's Story: A Better Night's Sleep for a Better School Day

Walín, 17, had been sleeping on an air mattress that deflated overnight, leaving him on the floor most mornings. His family had recently moved and couldn't afford a bed for him. Struggling with discomfort and exhaustion, he mentioned it to his guidance counselor at school, who reached out to *A Bed for Every Child*.

Not long after, Walín received a brand-new bed of his own. No more waking up sore just a real bed where he can finally rest. With better sleep, he can now focus on school without the weight of exhaustion holding him back.
